The Society of Southwest Archivists John Michael Caldwell Student Scholarship, named in memory of a former officer and board member and Southwestern archivist, will pay registration and reimburse costs of travel, lodging and per diem expenses up to a maximum of \$600 for an SSA member enrolled in a graduate archival program to attend the 2010 annual meeting April 27 – May 2 in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

**Eligibility:** Applicant must be a member of the Society of Southwest Archivists currently enrolled in a graduate archival education program, including Public History, Applied History, Library Science or Information Studies, at an institution within the SSA region, Arizona, Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Oklahoma and Texas.
