The Society of Southwest Archivists A. Otis Hebert, Jr., Continuing Education Scholarship, honoring SSA's founding president, will reimburse the costs of registration, travel, lodging and per diem up to a maximum of \$1,000 for a practicing archivist in the Southwest to attend an archival workshop, institute or other continuing education activity. The scholarship is especially intended to help an archivist whose institution may not be able to support continuing education.

Eligibility: Must be a practicing archivist in Arizona, Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Oklahoma, or Texas with at least one year of experience working in archives and manuscripts.
